

## WalesGolf Network Members Reciprocal Golf Scheme

Each Club in the network makes available 2 tee times per day Monday to Friday as being available to other **WalesGolf Network** Club Members. Once those times are taken, it is at the discretion of the host club as to whether they will allow further tee times on that day. On days where the host Club is busy with Golf Societies, Club Matches, Club Competitions etc, the Host club has the option to not offer any tee times on that day.

### Rules

1. Reciprocal Golf is available to all Full and 5 Day Male and Female Members of a **WalesGolf** Network Club. 5 Day Members only have 5 Day access at Network Clubs
2. Each **WalesGolf** Network Club will allocate two tee times per day, Monday to Friday, for use by Members of other **WalesGolf** Network Clubs. Any additional Tee Times per day are at the discretion of the individual **WalesGolf** Network Club.
3. Each **WalesGolf** Network Club will make available, subject to availability and at times appropriate to their club, some weekend access.
4. Every Full or 5 Day Member of a **WalesGolf** Club is entitled to play one round of golf per annum at other courses in the **WalesGolf** Network.
5. A Club Member, wishing to play at a **WalesGolf** Network Club, must contact the relevant **WalesGolf** network Club between two and five days in advance to book a suitable time and date for their round. Free Rounds may only be booked with less than two days notice, at the discretion of the Host Club.
6. The Club Member will be required to produce their Club voucher, obtainable from the home club professional, on arrival at the **WalesGolf** Network Club in order to obtain their free round.
7. A Full Member of a **WalesGolf** Club may take guests with them to other **WalesGolf** Network Clubs. A Guest is a golfer who is NOT a Full or 5 Day Member of a **WalesGolf** Network Club, or who is a 5 Day Member but playing at the weekend with a Full Member. All Guests will be required to play the standard Guest Green Fee of the **Wales Golf** Network Club where the round is played.
8. Full Members (and their guests) of a **WalesGolf** Network Club will be honorary members of the Host **WalesGolf** Network Club for the day and able to use the clubhouse, catering and bar facilities on the day of their round. Cost of food and drink is not included in this offer.
9. Full and 5 Day Members of a **WalesGolf** Network Club will not be given a courtesy round unless the round has been pre-booked in accordance with 5. above
10. All golfers must comply with the Host **WalesGolf** Network Club Rules and the Dress Code of that Club
11. Where more than one consecutive tee time is required, ie for groups of greater than 4 golfers, one Reciprocal Tee time will be available free of charge, and all additional starting times will be charged at the specially reduced rates as advertised by each **WalesGolf** Network Club.
