GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- 1) An event form may be picked up at either golf course and submitted for approval to the Parks and Recreation Director.
2) Groups must follow all rules as posted for normal play at the golf courses.
3) The Golf Course Superintendent has the right to close the course at any time when damage may occur to the course.
4) Any damage to the course, clubhouse or equipment caused by the group, will be the responsibility of the sponsoring group and the assessed damage amount will be payable within 7 days from the date of the tournament.
5) Food and soft drinks--facilities are available at each golf course for food and beverage service. All food and beverage must be purchased through the On-Site food and beverage provider. Check with respective golf course for menu and costs.
6) Colorado State Liquor Code requires that only alcoholic beverages purchased at the respective golf course may be consumed on the premises of the course, this is a State Law and group hosts are responsible for communicating this to their participants.
7) Payment for food, beverages, and all additional charges of the group must be made by the completion of the event.
8) In the case of failure to comply with the Course guidelines, person(s) responsible for violations will be asked to leave the premises after an initial warning.
9) Lincoln Park and Tiara Rado Golf Courses are spikeless facilities. Please notify participants and ask them to wear spikeless footwear.

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES:

- 1) Tournament fees:
A tournament deposit of \$125.00 must accompany all requests to host an event with the City of Grand Junction, this fee will reserve the course for the agreed upon date. For approved tournaments, this deposit will be credited against the \$125.00 fee to host a shotgun event tournament fee.

Per player fees for approved outings:

Table with 4 columns: Day, 9 Holes - LP, TR, 18 Holes - LP, TR. Rows for Monday-Thursday and Friday, Sat, Sun, Holidays.

Note: Per player fee for tournaments includes green fees, cart fees, and a \$5.00 fee per player fee for golf shop prizes

** Tournaments with 100+ players will include range balls and play for \$50.00 and \$55.00 per player based on day of the week

Tournament Guidelines Continued

Additional fees:

Tournament Discount for Range Balls: Warm Up Basket is \$3 per player

Rental Golf carts: We will bill the event \$25 per cart that we have to rent

- 2) If the event is canceled due to weather it will be rescheduled if an alternate date is available. If no date is available, or the group wishes, a refund will be given, less prorated use of equipment and holes completed. The tournament deposit fee is non-refundable if the tournament is cancelled by the tournament organizers.
- 3) Tournaments are responsible for payment of 20% of their estimated players 10 days prior to the event to ensure that the golf course can fill tee times if there is a shortage of players or cancellation. If the event is cancelled after this deadline this payment will be forfeited.
- 4) The final player count must be given at least 2 days prior to the event so that accommodations for the event may be completed.
- 5) The per player fee for all players **MUST** be received by respective golf course on the day of the event or prior to the event (Season ticket pricing is **NOT** valid during tournament play). Players that no show will be charged if they were included in the final player list.
 - a) A group which has fewer players than requested and paid for will receive no refunds.
 - b) Groups will only be allotted tee times for the number of players that are prepaid. Additional players will be subject to availability of starting times or additional holes (Shotgun Only).
- 5) Shotgun starts for events:
 - a) A group must have a minimum of 36 and up to a maximum of 72 players (Lincoln Park), and 80 player minimum up to 144 maximum players (Tiara Rado) to close the course for a shotgun start. Shotgun starts on weekends will be in the A.M. only. Groups with less than minimum for a shotgun can pay per player fees for a minimum and have a shotgun start. Groups with less than the minimum number and not wishing to pay additional fees will be given starting times. Starting times will begin no sooner than noon on weekends. 1:00 P.M. shotguns Monday through Thursday will not be subject to the same minimum player requirements as Friday – Sunday outings.
