

## How to pick a partner for a team event



Handicap guys suggest you match Steady Eddie with Wild Willy. You want to be in every hole (close to net par) and Eddie puts you there. If you're Eddie, you should be looking for Willy, who will give you a chance to score net birdies and eagles. A good way to determine who's who is to compare "anti-handicaps"—a number based on a golfer's 10 worst scores out of the last 20 instead of the 10 best, which is how handicaps are calculated. Eddie's anti-handicap will be close to his real handicap. Wild Willy's will be much, much higher. Above all, choose someone you like, preferably a good putter, someone who plays at about the same pace as you, and someone who is forgiving—of you and himself.
