Ride-on Buggy Policy, Terms and Conditions

Introduction

Fairfield Golf and Sailing Club's course is not considered ideally suited for ride-on buggies.

The use of privately owned buggies is restricted to members or visitors who are disabled or have medical or physical conditions which preclude the physical carrying of golf clubs.

Fairfield Golf and Sailing Club will not accept liability for any loss or damage to privately owned buggies or any other property arising from the negligence of the Club or any of its servants or agents.

Users of privately owned buggies do so entirely at their own risk. The Club reserves the right to prohibit such use should it be deemed the buggy is 'not fit for purpose'.

Terms and Conditions

In order that these conditions can in practice be met, the Club's approved nominee, namely the club Professional or qualified member of the professional shop, must whenever possible, be given prior notice of a requirement by a member, visitor or guest to use a ride-on buggy. The Club reserves the right to refuse permission if some or all of the conditions stipulated are not complied with.

- The Club staff may determine that the state of the course or the weather is such that safety on or the condition of the course may be unacceptably compromised if a privately owned ride-on buggy is used. During adverse conditions, use will be subject to health and safety criteria and accessibility to the whole or parts of the course.
- Any person who operates a ride-on-buggy on the golf course is deemed by so doing, to have the knowledge, training and skill to safely operate this vehicle and be fully accountable for their actions and the consequences thereof.
- All ride-on-buggy owners must provide a copy of a valid certificate of insurance providing cover for third party risk of at least £1,000,000 (one million pounds) and annual certification of servicing showing that the buggy is in good working order.
- The Club reserves the right to withdraw authorisation if the medical condition or disability necessitating the use of a ride-on buggy ceases, or, the conditions for its use are not fully complied with.
- Ride-on buggies must be operated and parked in such a manner that they do not impede or interfere with normal pedestrian or vehicular flow on roadways, ramps or pavements.
- No ride-on buggy will be operated in excess of 15km per hour. All speed limits must be observed.
- Ride-on buggies shall be used only between dawn and dusk.
- Ride-on buggies must be operated in compliance with the common` rules of the road` regardless of whether ride-on buggies are operated on pavements or roadways.

- The consumption of alcohol and/or the improper use of drugs is not permitted when using the ride-on buggy.
- The Club Secretary, Club Professional, their agent or Member of the Council has the authority to immediately prohibit any individual from using or being carried on a ride-on buggy. Application for reinstatement of permission can only be made to the Club.
- Ride on buggies must follow the designated route defined on the attached map. Where a shortened course is in operation users must comply with such instructions given on the day.

Golfers must complete and sign the Buggy Policy, Terms and Conditions Form and hand it in to the Pro Shop / Club Office, prior to operating their own ride-on buggy on Fairfield Golf and Sailing Club Course.
