NEW COMPETITIONS PROCESSES

The new ClubV1 web based competitions and handicapping software has been installed and is operational.

The Club is now on **HowDidiDo** (HDID) so all members can log on to the HDID website to create their own account by registering their details. N.B. The username you use must be the email address that is contained in the Club's database. Your HDID account will allow you to remotely book a time for a competition, view and print a handicap certificate, as well as providing detailed analyses of your scoring and access to other clubs' results (especially useful for open events).

There will be 2 PSI (Player Score Input) terminals in the clubhouse, viz.

1. one outside the secretary's office – used to "Book a Competition Time Zone" or "Sign-in" on the competition day.
2. one in the bar – used to "Book a Competition Time Zone" or "Score Input" on the competition day.

Both terminals can be used to request a handicap certificate or see the handicap list at any time. **You can use your swipe card or PIN Number on your card** to access the terminal functions.

Competition Charging will now be done differently, utilising a "Competitions Purse" which is available on your swipe card. Your swipe card now has 2 "Purses"...one for your bar account and one for your competitions account. The bar levy will appear in your bar purse and cannot be transferred to your competitions purse. Your competitions purse must be topped up in exactly the same way as your bar purse, i.e. using cash at the bar. Competition winners will receive SGU vouchers as normal, however Sweep and/or Two's winnings will be added to your competitions purse by the Match Secretary. Money may be moved from your competitions purse to your bar purse, but not vice-versa.

- Cash will not be accepted by the competition Starter.
- At Competition Sign-in (on the day of the competition) the mandatory Entry Fee of £2.00 will be deducted from your competitions purse, and you will be given the option to enter the Sweep (£0.50) and the Two's (£0.50) which will also be deducted from your competitions purse.

Competition Booking - booking a time zone for a competition can be done using the terminals in the clubhouse or remotely using your HDID account. Saturday Competitions will open for booking at noon on the Friday the week before, and close at noon on the Friday the day before. You can make changes to your booking up to noon on the Friday before, thereafter any change/cancellation requests must be made to the Match Secretary/Starter. "Pink" times will be available to book on the day of the competition as normal, only via the Starter . . . not remotely. Actual playing 3-balls will be determined as usual by the Starter on the day. **Tuesday Competitions** - No 'Time Zone' bookings will be available for Tuesday Competitions - these will continue to be self start on the day, although Sign-In and Score Entry will be as per the new processes - competitions entry will be paid using the competitions purse on your swipe card.

Booking a Time Zone will be available using either of the two PSI terminals in the clubhouse or remotely using your **HowDidiDo** account. Booking will open at noon on Friday February 14th and close at noon on Friday February 21st. "Pink" times will be available to be booked on Saturday 22nd as usual at the office via the Starter.

Sign-in to the competition on Saturday 22nd will be by using the PSI terminal at the office only. NO CASH will be accepted at Sign-in. Please ensure you have topped up your Competitions Purse on your swipe card as the money will be taken off this purse at Sign-in. Topping Up can be done at the bar.

Score Entry on Saturday 22nd will only be available using the PSI upstairs in the bar.

Sweep/Two's winnings will be added to the relevant competition purses on Monday February 24th.
