

## LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- (a) Beyond all boundary fences, walls or hedges surrounding the course and clubhouse.
- (b) 1st hole - To the right of line of white markers.
- (c) 3rd hole - Over the rabbit fencing on the right hand side of the fairway.
- (d) 9th Hole - Over the burn to the right of the fairway.
- (e) 10th to 17th holes - on or over the road.
- (f) 18th hole - To the right of line of white markers.

### 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

The ditches crossing the 3rd, 17th and 18th holes, and to the right and left of the 16th fairway are water hazards, defined by yellow markers.

### 3. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

All areas and ditches defined by red stakes shall be deemed lateral water hazards.  
Rule 26 applies.

### 4. STAKED TREES

Staked trees are immovable obstructions and relief should be taken under rule 24-2.

### 5. OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24)

(a) The commemorative stone behind the 18th green is an immovable obstruction and relief should be taken in accordance with rule 24-2.

#### (b) PATHS THROUGHOUT THE COURSE

A ball coming to rest on or against an artificial surface used to create a path, or on or against an artificial surface used to create an edge to a path, may be lifted and dropped without penalty. Relief should be taken in accordance with rule 24-2
