



HOLE 1: This first hole requires a good straight drive as there are OB stakes on the right and trees lining both sides of the fairway.

HOLE 2: This short par 4 is an easy hole to play, as it's reachable with irons and has only one sand trap. The green slopes towards the fairway, so leaving your approach shot on the front of the green is preferable. OB stakes on the left side.



HOLE 3: This first Par 3 offers you an extreme elevation change with a sloping green that rewards a shot below the hole. OB stakes line the right side and you don't want to leave it short. Add one club.

HOLE 4: OB stakes and houses line the right side of this fairway, so playing the left side is desirable. Over the green is also OB.



HOLE 5: This is your first hole without OB stakes, so let it rip! A draw shot works well here. The green is firm, so let your approach roll on.

HOLE 6: Straight forward Par 3 with OB stakes on your left. Wind sometimes comes into play here.



HOLE 7: This long Par 4 sets up well for a draw up the left side of the fairway. Only one sand trap over the green is OB.

HOLE 8: An easy hole without hazards. Just stay out of the small clump of trees on the right.



HOLE 9: This is the longest hole and most difficult, due to the trees in the middle and OB stakes on the left side of the fairway and over the green. A power fade works here if you can hit it long.
