

## **Pass Holder Responsibilities:**

### **Tee times**

Golfers need to reserve tee times on all occasions. Tee times may be reserved either by phone or by visiting the pro shop. A player's fee will be assessed at a rate of \$3 for 9 holes and \$5 for 18 holes per pass holder before teeing off each round. All play will start from the first tee unless the group is directed to do otherwise by the pro shop staff.

### **Rules pertaining to general play on the golf course**

All players are required to observe playing rules and proper golf etiquette – particularly those listed below:

**\*Replace divots always**

**\*Repair ball marks**

**\*Smooth out all bunkers**

**\*Practice only in practice areas Range and Putting Green**

**\*Fivesomes are not allowed unless given special permission by the pro shop staff**

**\*Slower groups should allow faster groups to play through always.**

### **Golf cart rules**

**\*90 degree cart rule unless otherwise noted**

**\*A valid driver's license is required to operate golf carts.**

**\*If an additional cart is needed for a spectator, or player a cart fee will apply**

**\*Golf carts must be driven on cart paths wherever possible.**

**\*Carts are to be kept on cart path near tee boxes and Greens.**

**\*Cart path ONLY on Par 3's**

**\*Golf carts may not be driven in wooded areas, fescue or on severe grades.**

**\*A maximum of two persons per golf cart is allowed.**

### **Damage to the golf carts**

Golfers are asked to report any cart malfunctions immediately after their round, and are expected to return all carts to the pro shop in the condition which they were received. Golfers will be financially responsible for damage inflicted to the cart(s) during their time of rental.

### **Driving range policy**

Use of the driving range is governed by the pro shop. Set hours dictate when the range can be used. Range balls, bag rests and other range equipment are not to leave the range area. Golfers must return their basket upon completion of hitting range balls.

### **Alcoholic beverages**

No alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the golf course, except those that are purchased in the pro shop. Personal coolers and beverages purchased elsewhere are prohibited. Eagle creek staff reserves the right to confiscate any personal coolers/beverages not purchased at the club.

### **Complaints**

Any golfer wishing to make a complaint of any kind can do so to the general manager, Greg Mitchell.
