Peterhead Golf Club Bye-Laws

General

- 1.0** These Bye-laws shall not be subject to alteration at a club meeting except upon written notice given to the secretary at least fourteen days before the meeting setting forth the proposed alterations.
- 2.0** The committee shall have full power to alter, or add to these bye-Laws and to decide any points that may arise at a Club Competition or otherwise upon these Bye-Laws. Any Bye-Law made from time to time by the Committee shall become and remain binding from time to time on the members until altered by the committee or the club. A copy of all new Rules, Regulations and Bye-Laws shall forthwith be placed on the Notice Board in the Clubhouse, and shall thereby be held to be duly intimated to all concerned and shall immediately on posting become operative.
- 3.0** Any member acting in contravention of these Bye-Laws renders themselves liable to be dealt with in accordance with Rule 3 of the Constitution.
- 4.0** The Clubhouse shall be opened and closed at such hours as the Committee may determine.
- 5.0** No Notice or Documents of any kind shall be placed on the notice boards or on the walls of the clubhouse without the authority of the committee.
- 6.0** No person shall deface, injure or take or permit to be taken out of the clubhouse any newspaper, book or other articles belonging to the Club.
- 7.0** Members shall defray whatever expenses they incur before leaving the clubhouse. All breakages by members must be paid for by them at the same time.
- 8.0** Members are prohibited from buying golf balls from unauthorized persons in the vicinity of the course. Any member disregarding this Bye-Law may be dealt with in the terms of Rule 3 of the constitution.
- 9.0** All Children or Youths below the age of the legal limits for sale of alcohol or attending premises that has the sale of alcohol must comply with the licensing regulations with regards to authorized areas and timings.

For Play

- 1.0** The Rules of Golf, as they may from time to time be fixed by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, shall be the rules of play. Except in so far as these may be modified by any local rule adopted by the club.
- 2.0** The club fixtures for the year shall be arranged by the committee as soon as possible after the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the club. Notice of fixture arrangements shall be given to each member by either supplying with fixture card, via Web page or through the Notice Board.
- 3.0** The Committee may arrange additional fixtures during the year and notices of these shall be posted on the notice board or via Web page.
- 4.0** For competitions, there will be various handicap sections and categories, the committee will determine on how these will be regulated, any competitor competing in competitions failing to comply with the regulations shall be disqualified from further participation in the competition, all disputes regarding play in competitions shall be determined by the committee.
- 5.0** The handicaps of members shall be fixed by the committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 6.0** Members shall not enter any competition until they have been handicapped. The maximum handicaps shall be set by category and the committee.
- 7.0** Out with club completions the order of play will be via the clubs booking system that is in place and regulated by the committee. A game failing to make their allotted time must give way to the following group and then accept the next available time via the system. All club authorized or match competitions must also be booked via the club booking system.
- 8.0** Competitions timings for all categories shall be regulated by the committee.
- 9.0** In all competitions competitors scores must be kept and certified by their partners. In event of no partner being available, any competitor may have their score marked by a member not competing, but only on approval of a member of the committee. All scores must be entered into the handicap competition computer and all scores cards must be duly signed by both persons, and clearly marked with date, time, club number, handicap along with relevant competition entered. Failure to complete both action prior to the close of the competition will result in disqualification of such competition.
- 10.0** If on the day appointed for any competition / general play the course s are unplayable, such competitions or general play may be postponed. Competitions shall be fixed by the committee and notice thereof shall be posted on the notice board and via web page.
- 11.0** Three (3) and Four (4) ball games in general play must give way to Single (1) on the course, except when such games are competing in a club competition.

12.0 Juniors play on the old course will be regulated by the committee.

13.0 Players shall not break in at any hole during the course of their round if, by doing so they interfere in any way with players playing a full round.

14.0 There will be no practice play on the Old course

15.0 Every player is required to replace or seed, turf cut or removed by them during play and players found neglecting this duty are liable to be dealt with under rule 3 of the constitution.

16.0 Players shall not take their Caddie cars or buggies either manual or motorized of any description onto the prepared surface of putting greens and the immediate areas adjacent to these putting surfaces. All Caddie cars or buggies must adhere to the authorized traffic routes regulated by the committee.

17.0 Members and visitors are prohibited from having animals (except for disabled purposes) with them in the club house. Animals are not allowed on the course except on a leash and within control of the owner.

This Bye-Laws has been approved in accordance with the constitution 10.2, and accepted as the Bye-Laws for the Peterhead Golf Club,
