

# 2018 MULES NATIONAL SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION



The Wednesday Morning Senior Golf League was developed to promote golf, meet others, have fun and play the game of golf according to USGA rules. The Association is open to any male age 50 or older.

Included in this packet is a pre-planned weekly event schedule starting March 7, and ending November 14, 2018. This 2018 event schedule is subject to change.

If you decide to join the Association, our annual membership fee is \$60.00. **Make checks payable to: SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION.** Annual fee breakdown:

- \$ 20.00 U.S.G.A. Handicap System
- \$ 12.50 League Championship, President's Cup, etc.
- \$ 23.00 Planned Lunches and Annual Fish Fry
- \$ 3.50 Misc.
- \$ 1.00 Hole-in-one pot (Hole-N-One's during league sponsored play will receive a max. of \$50)

Association weekly fees for senior league events are: cart fee \$11.00\*, green fee \$10.00\*, entry fee \$5.00\*\*, skins \$1.00 and trail fee \$5.00 If you intend to play more than 18 holes, you must pay for any additional cart usage. All entry winnings and skins will be paid in cash and the \$1.00 weekly hole contests will be in gift certificates. \*Members of Mules National do not pay this fee. \*\*\$4.00 to cash winnings, and \$1.00 to gift certificates.

As a member of the Association, you are required to sign up for the next week play in advance (no later than Tuesday - Noon) on the sign-up sheet or by phone in the pro shop. By signing up in advance, this helps establish pairings, and to get everyone out on the course on time. This is most important when two man events are scheduled. We don't want to have to turn away the odd man out. We do have a weekly meeting held fifteen minutes prior to scheduled playing time. This meeting is for announcements and to discuss any golf rule issues or changes. For example; 8:00 AM start, meeting will be at 7:45 AM.

Part of your Association fee is for U.S.G.A. Handicap System. This is a software package to track your scores and provides a handicap that is used for pairings, net events, tournaments, and championships. **It is your responsibility to record your golfing rounds\* using this provided service. The computer in the pro shop is yours to use. Effective 5-16-2018, all members must have a establish GHIN handicap posted to receive any entry fee winnings in any individual net, team events, league championship, and President's Cup. These measures were created to eliminate any discontent within the senior league regarding handicaps.**

\*The Pro Shop Staff will be responsible for posting all Wednesday league scores this year. **It will be your responsibility to post scores from play other than on Wednesdays.** After league rounds, turn in your score card to the pro shop where it will be handled accordingly. Please make sure the score card is neat and legible in order to avoid any confusion. If someone fails to turn in a Wednesday Senior League scorecard, an even par score will be posted for that round, and **no entry fee winnings will be paid out.**

**The senior league plays by U.S.G.A. and all local rules.** It is important that each member has an understanding of these golfing rules, producing positive and consistent interpretation of the rules when

questions or issues arise between players or groups. **Without exception, all putts must be holed out, no gimmie putts. We will play the ball up one grip length everywhere, except out of bounds, hazards, sand traps, fringe areas, and greens.**

In this packet is an information sheet. **Please be sure to fill in all information, most importantly, your tee box choice. If you fail to make which tee box choice, you will be automatically assigned to the Gray Tees.** The desire of the Senior League is for everyone to play from the Grey Tees. However, we want our membership to enjoy the game of golf, therefore, our senior league play from both Grey and Red Tee boxes under the following guidelines.

- We will be using the USGA handicap adjustment for playing from different tees when our scheduled event mixes players from both tee boxes. The course rating from the Grey Tees is 64.8, from the Red Tees is 62.2. The differential ( $64.8 - 62.2 = 2.6$ ) is rounded to 3. **Therefore, Red Tee players, playing in a mixed tee event will have 3 strokes subtracted from their handicap.**
- For example(s): This handicap method is used to determine A-B-C-D players in scheduled flight and team events, and, also, to determine the players net score in handicap events.
- Those members playing from the Red Tees will not have the choice of moving back to the Grey Tees once league play starts. Exception(s): (1) Players may move back to the Grey Tees during the league championship if they want to be eligible for low gross overall champion, (2) Medical reasons, cleared by the Club Pro and President of the Association.

### **Senior Golf Association League Championship July 18 and July 25, 2018**

Only members who have a required a minimum of five 2018 rounds are eligible to play in the League Championship

The Senior League Champion will be the low 36 hole GROSS score and must play from the Grey Tees. Also, the championship will have three gross and three net flights (Two gross and net flights from the Grey Tees, and One gross and net flight from the Red Tees). For Grey Tee players, your handicap determines which gross or net flight you will be in. Members can only place in one flight, whichever flight you finished the highest in.

All players must play on the designated dates, both with an 8 AM start (weather permitting).

Pairings for the 18th are based on your handicap. Pairings for the 25th are based on your score from the 18th.

Cost: \$10.00 for entry fees by each player will be paid on the first day of the club championship to help build prize fund. \$5.00 of the entry fee will go to the League Championship and \$5.00 will go to the weekly prize payouts on the 18th and 25th. If you can only play one of two championship dates, you would pay the \$5.00 entry fee for the prize money for that day's event. \$1.00 skins will also be collected on each date. Prize payout in each flight will be in cash, and hole contests in gift certificates. There will be two closest to the pin contest on each date.

For Mules National non-members, Green fees of \$9.00, and Cart fees of \$11.00 will be collected each date.

**All USGA and local rules apply. All putts must be holed, no leather or gimmies allowed.**
