

Thursday Night Men's League
2018 Season-Rules and Information

General

- All USGA and local course rules apply to league play
- Limited to the 56 players (28 teams)
- Entry fees include GHIN #, End of Season Party, Range Balls and End of Season / Playoff payouts
- Weekly League fee includes Greens fee, Cart, and Weekly prizes

Format

- Two Person Better Ball of Partners

Cost

- Entry fee
 - Member - \$100
 - Non-Member - \$125
- Weekly League fee
 - Member - \$5.00
 - Non-Member - \$25.00

Handicaps

- GHIN handicap is required to be kept here at RMGL in order to participate in league play. If not the player plays to a zero handicap
- Maximum handicap for all league golfers and subs will be eighteen (18) strokes for all divisions.
- Handicap's are calculated at 90% and played off of the low in the four-ball.

Teams & Matches

- All matches will be played on scheduled nights at 5:00 or 5:30 PM (dependent on sunset) unless the course deems it not possible due to an holiday, outing or weather
- Rain dates-the maximum that will be made up is 2 weeks at the end of the season. All players will be notified if league night is cancelled due to rain or any form of inclement weather
- In the event of rain once matches have started: If five (5) holes are completed, the match is official. The balance of the holes will be forced based on the results of the completed holes
- If the entire opposing team is not present, play will be against par.

Alternates/Subs

- Alternates/Subs may be used, if available. In the case of no available subs, the single team member plays his own ball against the other two-person team. Alternates must keep a GHIN handicap at RMGL. If not the player plays to a zero handicap

Scoring

- Scoring will be on a ten (10) point system which is as follows:
 - .5 per team for holes halved or 1 point for the team who wins the hole
 - 1 point for the team who wins the most points in the match, if tied each team wins .5 of the final point.
- Gross scores should be entered per hole and not “1up, 1down, etc.”
- Scores should be counted and added prior to submission. Reminder, each scorecard should be signed and attested. Once the card is signed, no revisions will be allowed other than errors in computation
- Please take a picture of your scorecard for backup purposes
- All putts must be putted out, NO GIMMIES!
- All will play from the White Tees

Schedule

- One 10 team division
- Round Robin Schedule – handed out week 1

Playoffs

- Top four (8) teams will make the playoffs. Finals will also include a consolation match to determine 3rd and 4th place

Payouts

- Weekly – Low Gross, Skins, Closest to the Pin and Long Drive
- Regular Season Division Champion
- Playoff – 1st thru 8th
