Season Long Points Contest and Sweeps Championship Information

Season Long Points Contest

What: During the 2018 season, Riverside Golf Course will be offering a season long points competition. Points will be awarded based on the results from each individual sweeps day. Points will be awarded for Individual (Gross/Net), 2Ball (Gross/Net), Points, and Skins (Gross/Net). Pins and any other competitions that are offered weekly will not accumulate points. See the following page for the point's structure.

When: Points will start to accumulate during the first sweeps day of the 2018 season and run until Sunday September 9th. Points will only accumulate on Saturday and Sundays when sweeps are offered and that have a minimum of 30 players. The Sweeps Championship will take place on Sunday September 23rd. The points standings will be posted on the 1st and 15th of each month.

Who: Anyone and everyone who plays in the sweeps will accumulate points. You will need to enter the contest to be awarded points. (For example, if you only pay \$2 to enter individual, you can't accumulate points for 2ball, skins, points, etc). On September 12th the final results will be posted and the top **60** players will advance to the Sweeps Championship. See the additional page for the Championship information.

Sweeps Championship Day Information

When: The competition will take place on Sunday September 23rd 2018

Who: The top 60 players in the season long points contest will qualify and be invited to the Sweeps Championship. If you are in the top 60 and choose not to participate or can't for any reason, the next player in the standings will take the spot. The field will be 60 players.

Format: To keep the competition as fair as possible, the 15 pairings will be determined by ABCD random draw prior to the event, once the field is finalized. Each pairing will have 4 players. The regular games will take place, 2Ball, Individual, Points, Skins, and Pins.

Cost: Once you qualify for the Sweeps Championship, there will be a \$20 entry fee to compete on that day. The pot will be \$1,200 and Riverside Golf Course will provide additional funds to increase the pot to at least \$1,500.00.

Why: The idea behind the Points Race and the Sweeps Championship is to encourage every player to get into the sweeps to some extent. **Every point you accumulate during the year will help you gain entry into the most lucrative sweeps game Riverside has ever offered.**
