As we head into Fall there are lots of things going on. First on the list is the **Guys and Dolls Tournament**. This is an event put on by the Madrona Ladies' Club, and it is an event not to be missed. Two-person teams are made up of one man and one woman. The format is Chapman. The entry fee of \$160 per couple includes golf and lunch. There's a great raffle at the end, as well. If you don't have a partner, sign up as a single at the desk and they will do their best to pair you with a partner.

The same weekend as the Guys and Dolls is the **TGA Sweeps**, a two-man best ball competition. The competition runs three days, but you don't need to play all three days. Each day is a separate event. This is a two-man format, and you can pair with everyone in your foursome, if you wish. The only limitation is a 7 stroke maximum differential in handicaps. Entry fee is \$16 per pair. You may play all three days, but you can only win once with a particular partner. You can change partners and win each day.

Next up is the **Three Formats Tournament** (also called the 6-6-6). Note that the date is different than that shown on your Men's Club Membership Card. It is on September 22. This is a two-man event, and gets its name from the fact that you play six holes in Chapman format, six holes in best-ball format, and six holes counting both scores.

Finally we have the **Gig Harbor City Amateur**, a two-day tournament. Your \$150 entry fee includes a practice round during the week (Monday through Thursday), tee prizes, two meals and two drink tickets. The tournament is flighted, and there is a guaranteed payout of \$750 for the gross and net champions. Get an entry form at the Madrona Links website. (www.madronalinks.com)
