

EXPERIENCE TROON GOLF

## 1. Out-of-Bounds (Rule 27-1)

- a) Beyond any fence or line of white posts bounding the course.
- b) A ball coming to rest on or over the Pompano Road is out of bounds when playing holes 2, 3 and 5.
- c) The driving range to the left of hole 9.

### 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

- a) Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes or lines.
- b) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines.

# 3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

- a) All artificially surfaced roads and paths and adjacent edgings.
- b) All buildings and walls.
- c) Drain covers.

#### 4. Protection of Young Trees

Protection of young trees identified by stakes. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball MuST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule-24-2b (Immovable Obstructions).

## 5. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 23-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 23-1 applies).

## 6. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole; the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES 4 & 6
Match Play - Loss of hole; Stroke Play - Two strokes.
