*Paying adult is considered to be a parent/guardian, over the age of 21 who has paid for golf, cart, or both and has signed the JIGC Code of Conduct.



Enrollment

As a member of the Junior Illini Golf Club, you have a responsibility to the golf course and to the other golfers on the course. Following the rules is an important part of the game of golf.

These rules are set up to protect junior golfers, other golfers, the golf course and the staff. Failure to follow these rules may result in membership being revoked.

1. Golf privileges are only available after 10am and are subject to availability.
2. Tee times can be made in advance online at www.uofigolf.com or by phone at 217-359-5613.
3. All members must be accompanied by a paying adult. An adult is defined as over 21 years of age. An accompanying adult must also sign a Code of Conduct prior to playing with the member or accompanying them in any way. An adult must accompany the member to check-in.
4. No members are permitted to drive or steer the golf carts.
5. The golf course has specific cart rules that must be followed. These can change daily and it is the responsibility of the accompanying adult to know the rules for the day. Carts are never permitted on the tees or greens. Carts should remain on the path as much as possible.
6. Proper pace of play should be maintained. Allow faster golfers to play through.
7. Proper behavior including, but not limited to, the following must be displayed at all times by both the member and the adult:
 - a. Refrain from using abusive, obscene or vulgar language
 - b. Show respect to other golfers and the course staff
 - c. Do not throw clubs, swing violently or erratically
 - d. Care for the course. Any mistreatment is considered a violation.
 - e. Proper attire is required at all times.

As a member of the Junior Illini Golf Club or an accompanying adult, I will follow all rules listed in the Code of Conduct. I understand that failure to follow these rules may lead to loss of membership and privileges.
