- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - On or over the road at the 1st hole.
 - Beyond any fence or wall bounding the course.
 - Beyond the line of white stakes bounding the 1st, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th 11th & 18th (not on right hand side of 18th).
 - The wall between the 8th & 9th fairways defines out of bounds for both holes.
 - WALLS** - All remaining walls are integral parts of the course.
 - GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)** If a ball comes to rest in an area marked by (a) GUR sign, (b) an enclosed white line, (c) marked by blue posts, relief **MUST** be taken.
 - YOUNG STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2b (1))** If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed.
 - ALL PATHS AND ROADS** are integral parts of the course, with the exception of the buggy track at the 12th & 17th where relief may be taken.
 - TRACTOR MARKS (Rule 25-1b)** A player whose ball is lying in a tractor mark may obtain relief.
 - DISTANCE MARKERS (Rule 24-2)** Relief for interference by them may be obtained.
 - STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)** Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
 - BRIDGES (Rule 24-2)** A ball coming to rest on any part(s) of a bridge outwith the hazard, relief may be taken.
- DISTANCE MARKERS** A yellow disk in the fairway and green posts with two white rings mark **150 yards to the centre of the green.**
- PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:**
 Match Play - Loss of hole,
 Stroke Play - Two Strokes.
- SUSPENSION OF PLAY -**
 One blast of Klaxon
- CANCELLATION OF PLAY -**
 Two loud blasts of Klaxon.
