The Timberlake Ladies Golf Association (TLGA) was founded in 1988 with the purpose of promoting, fostering, regulating and developing amateur golf activities among the members. The association has grown to over forty-five members, many who meet and play golf on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings of each week. There is an active 9 Holer group who also have tee times on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings. Three times a year both the18 and 9 holers participate in a "Captain's Choice" event with lunch afterwards. The annual awards luncheon is held to present prizes to players in various categories for the previous golfing season — scoring birdies and pars and most-improved golfer. Business meetings are held monthly and offer members an opportunity to interact with fellow golfers who have a shared interest in promoting golf at the Timberlake Country Club.

As a recognized organization of Timberlake Country Club, the members of TLGA are eligible to participate in the Women's South Carolina Golf Association (WSCGA) tournaments which are held monthly at different courses around the state. Members are also entitled to participate in the "Sandlapper" tournaments held monthly at Columbia area courses. The Sandlapper tournaments use a modified Stableford scoring for the competition. Lunch, with the entrants in the tournament, is held after the round of golf is completed.

Both experienced and beginner golfers are welcome and encouraged to join the TLGA. Rules and skills clinics are presented during the year to encourage more ladies to play golf!
