LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27 APPLIES)**
 - Beyond any wall or fence bounding the course.
 - 9th hole – beyond the white 'chain link' fence behind the green.
 - 14th hole – beyond the 'chain link' fence & white line on the right.
 - 3rd & 4th holes – beyond the 'out of bounds' posts behind the 3rd green.
- DEFINING BOUNDS & MARGINS** (Rule 33-2a applies).
Out of Bounds: White Stakes, Water Hazard: Yellow Stakes, Lateral Water Hazards: Red Stakes. Bridges are part of the hazard.
- BUILT-UP TEES** (Rule 28 applies) Steps and drinking fountain are integral parts of the course.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 24-2 applies)
 - All buildings within the bounds of the course.
 - All bellposts, guide posts, footpaths and yardage plates.
 - Metal covers on the wells on the 8th, 11th and 16th holes.
- STONES IN BUNKERS** These are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)
- TREES AND HEDGES** All trees and hedges are an integral part of the course with the exception of newly planted trees identified by yellow topped stakes. If such a tree interferes with stance or swing relief must be taken within one club length not nearer the hole (Rule 24-2b).
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS** (Rule 24-2 applies)
All sprinkler heads and water hydrant covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained. In

- addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the ball and the intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief. The ball may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- DRAINAGE HOLES** (Rule 24-2 applies) Drainage holes on any green or apron of green. If a ball comes to rest on or near a drainage hole it may be lifted without penalty and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. On the putting green the player shall place the ball at the nearest spot not nearer the hole, which avoids the situation.
 - OVERHEAD POWER CABLES** (Rule 33-8/13 applies) overhead power cables on the 15th and 17th holes. A ball striking overhead cables must be re-played from the same position without penalty.
 - DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES** For all play at Crompton and Royton Golf Club, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is **disqualification**, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
