

## USE OF CARTS

1. Riding Golf Carts and pull carts are available and may be rented from the Pro Shop. Operation of rented riding carts is restricted to persons over the age of eighteen (18). No more than two (2) people are allowed in a riding cart.
2. Riding carts must be operated carefully. The operator of a riding cart assumes all responsibility for any and all injuries suffered by any person and for any damages to the golf cart, Club property or to property of others resulting from its use. wee will not be held responsible and the operator and passenger shall hold wee blameless for any liability arising from golf cart usage.
3. Riding carts must be kept at least thirty (30) feet from all greens, tees and sand bunkers (unless a cart path is used.) Signs, posts and ropes must be observed and care taken to avoid wet spots. Carts are not to be driven between greens and bunkers, nor across greens or tees, and never in bunkers.
4. The Golf course Superintendent has the authority and responsibility to limit or deny the use of riding carts (or other carts) on specific areas, or the entire course, at any time, as conditions dictate.
5. Hand operated pull or push carts and power carts must be kept off all aprons and fringes of greens, greens and tees, and are not allowed in sand bunkers. Please keep these carts on fairways, roughs, or on cart paths, or ten (10) feet away from greens and tees in the absence of a cart path, and vary your route around greens and traps so that the turf and subsoil is not worn or compacted.

## HANDICAPS

1. The USGA/MGA Course Rating is posted in the Pro Shop.
2. USGA/MGA Handicap System is available and offered free to wee members . wee maintains a computer access to "GHIN" (Golf Handicap Information Network) of the USGA.
3. Handicap Information Network) of the USGA.
4. Each Member/player will be assigned a Local Club Player ID number and is primarily responsible for his or her own handicap and the proper posting of scores.
5. WCC's Golf Committee is the final arbiter on all handicap matters.

## THE GOLF COURSE

1. WCC is a "soft-spike-only" Golf Course. No metal spikes are allowed anywhere.
2. Please replace your divots. and repair ball marks on the greens. A Player should ensure any turf cut or displaced is replaced at once and pressed down. Please repair any ball marks found on the putting surface.
3. Players should ensure that when handling the flagstick no damage is done to the putting surface. The flagstick should be carefully removed and later properly replaced in the hole before leaving the green.
4. Before leaving a sand bunker, a player should carefully fill in and rake all depressions and footprints made and/or observed in the immediate proximity of the player.
5. Players should avoid causing damage to the course by making divots when making practice swings. This applies particularly to tees and fairways.
6. The golf course should not be used for practice . Practice areas are provided for such use.
7. Please be courteous to the Greens Crews. Their presence on the course is essential, and any delay they may cause will be rewarded to you by a better maintained golf course for you to play.

## THE CLUB HOUSE

1. Proper attire is required at all times.
2. Pets are not allowed in the Club House or on the Patio.
3. Please use the golf shoe cleaners provided before entering the Club House.
4. Proper conduct must be observed at all times. Appropriate behavior is expected of all Members toward other Members, Guests and Staff. Any Member or Guest conducting him or herself in an unbecoming manner will be asked to leave the Club premises, and a report of such behavior and action will be made to the Board of Directors by the Club House Manager for information and any action.

Aggressive behavior, profanity and vulgar expressions are unacceptable at Wahconah Country Club.

## HOURS AND PROCEDURES FOR PLAY

1. Course Hours (including Practice Areas) are as posted in the Pro Shop.
2. All golfers must check in at the Pro Shop before starting play.
3. Players in REGULAR ORDER (i.e. starting on the front nine holes first) have the privilege of continued play over players starting play on the back nine holes.
4. Players beginning on the 10th hole MUST first receive permission of the Pro Shop.
5. A lone player has no standing on the golf course and must give way to any group.
6. The maximum number of golfers playing in any one group is limited to a foursome unless otherwise allowed by the Pro Shop.
7. On Weekends and Holidays, there shall be no less than a threesome of players to reserve a tee time and/or begin play before 11:00 am unless otherwise allowed by Pro Shop..
8. Reserved tee times are assigned seven (7) days a week from the Pro Shop.
9. An eighteen (18) hole round of golf should be completed in four (4) hours, and nine (9) holes in two (2) hours. Time searching for a lost ball should be limited to five (5) minutes.
10. Players stopping for more than five (5) minutes "at the tum" following the first nine (9) holes, must allow the group behind them the courtesy to play through.

## RULES GOVERNING PLAY AND DRESS CODE

1. Official USGA Rules govern all play. See Section I for "Etiquette on the Course."
2. For Local Rules see scorecard or consult the Golf Professional. Also see our Code of Conduct.
3. Proper attire is required on the Course, in the clubhouse and on the patio. Shirts with collars are required. Turtlenecks or fashionable mock turtlenecks are permitted. Shorts with pockets are acceptable. For Ladies: Shirts with collars and/or sleeves are acceptable.

4. The following are not allowed: Tank or halter tops, short or gym-type shorts or pants, sweats or cut-offs. From June 1st through Labor Day, dungarees or blue jeans are not allowed on the golf course.
5. The Golf Course Superintendent has the authority and responsibility to open and/or close the Golf Course and Practice areas to play, as circumstances warrant.
6. Tees are regulated for Tournaments and for Sanctioned League play.

    - Men's Afternoon Leagues 4-6 PM
  - Wednesday
    - Ladies' Morning League 9-10 AM
    - Ladies' Afternoon League 4-6PM

## PRACTICE AREAS AND DRIVING RANGE

1. Use of the Practice and Driving Range by Members and Guests at WCC is under supervision and control of the Golf Professional.
2. Only golf balls from the Pro Shop are to be used on the driving range. Range Policies, ball rates and Range Membership information is available at the Pro Shop.

## JUNIOR MEMBERS

1. Junior members at WCC have restricted membership and playing privileges. These restrictions apply to the golf course, range and putting areas. They shall start play from the first tee. On Weekends and Holidays they may not tee off before 4:00 pm. Weekdays they must tee off before 4:00 pm. It is also required that all Junior Members, not accompanied by an Adult Member, complete play and leave the golf and clubhouse facilities by 8:00 pm. Junior Members must also conform to the codes of conduct and dress code at WCC.

2. Exception: Junior members may start play after 2:00 on weekends and holidays and after 6:00 on weekdays, if they are accompanied by an adult (not an intermediate) member.

## LOCKER ROOMS

1. Locker rooms are available to Members and Guests at WCC. Lockers are available for annual rental by men and lady Golfing Members. Rented lockers are not shared facilities and are to be rented individually to men and ladies. Please contact the Golf Professional for information.
2. Storage of golf bags and/or hand carts in the locker rooms is not permitted for safety reasons. The Golf Professional offers this service for an annual fee.

## GREENS FEES FOR WCC CARD MEMBERS AND GUESTS

1. Weekday and Weekend/Holiday greens fee rates for WCC card members and non-member guests are established by the Board of Directors.
  - WCC Card Members will pay the "guest with member" rate each time they enter the course,
  - Guests of a traditional member will pay the "guest with member" rate.
  - Guests of a WCC Card Member will pay a reduced rate from the public rate.
  - Any person may pay "guest with member rate" no more than three times per month.
  - Please see our current year's rate sheet in the Pro Shop or on our website.
2. For accounting purposes, traditional members and WCC card members introducing Guests to WCC must sign in with their guest(s), and members must make payment for guests' green fees in the Pro Shop.
