Michael Devine as Juvenile Captain selected PANDA as his chosen charity during 2016 and with excellent support from Barbara Henderson (Juvenile Convenor) and Thomas Loughran (Professional Golf Pro) organised an evening at Blackwood Driving range for the children to experience golf for the first time – hitting numerous golf balls in a fun environment.
