

HYLAND HILLS WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION (18-Hole) GENERAL INFORMATION - 2019

- League play days are on **Tuesdays and Thursdays**. Members can play either day or both days!
- We play **18 holes on the Gold Course** at Hyland Hills in Westminster, Colorado: www.golfhylandhills.com
- Our season begins **May 1 and ends September 30**
- Tee times begin at **8:00 AM** during **May & September** and at **7:30 AM** during **June, July & August**
- **Tee times are normally assigned on Tuesdays**. Members may sign up for their own tee times on Thursdays. **Outside guests are also allowed on Thursdays**
- We are a “social” group but play according to the USGA Rules of Golfalong with a few local rules
- We play at all skill levels and most tournaments are handicapped and flighted
- We are a member of the Colorado Golf Association (CGA) and use the GHIN system for handicap purposes
- **Dues do not include green fees**
- **Two Membership meetings are held each year** – one in the Spring and one in the Fall
- **Members receive a Yearbook in May** which includes our membership roster,, tournament procedures, local rules and our tournament schedule for the season
- Members may play in our Northern Golf League/A-team (course handicaps 0 to 31) or our Northern Scenic League/B Team (course handicaps 17 to 32) competitions
- New Members are not eligible to participate in Club Championship or Most Improved Golfer

New Member Requirements:

- Players with an established USGA handicap that converts to a 40 or less course handicap on the 18-Hole Gold Course at Hyland Hills may join the Association once they have completed an application and paid the dues and initiation fee.
- New members who do not have a USGA handicap, may establish a temporary 18-hole handicap by submitting (to the Handicap Chairperson) at least five (5) scorecards, signed and attested, from a USGA rated 18 hole golf course. These rounds must have been played within the previous twelve (12) months. One (1) of these rounds must be played on the Hyland Hills 18-Hole Gold Course with a current member of the Association. Application, dues and initiation fee must accompany the scorecards. The Handicap Chairperson will compute the temporary handicap. If it converts to a 40 or less course handicap, the new member will be accepted. If not accepted, the dues and initiation fee will be refunded.
