Golf Course Superintendent:

Plans: Well last week was a mess, and this week is shaping up to be another fiasco! We need to spray the fairways and tees with fungicides, but this cannot be done in the rain.....but there is rain in the forecast almost every day of this week. We had planned on being closed today, and possibly tomorrow, for this application, but with an 80% chance of rain, it doesn't look promising. So here's the plan: We will close the course at our first opportunity to spray. Sorry. We won't be able to make that call ahead of time, so please check with the Pro Shop on a daily, and hourly, basis to see if we are open for play. We have been very fortunate with our planning, and scheduling for almost 14 straight years, so we were due for some disruption. We apologize for the uncertainty. Darn weather!!!

Blow Out: We will continue blowing out the irrigation system this week. Please watch out for sprinklers popping up without notice! "Defend yourselves at all times!"

Cover Up: In about a week, we will begin to install the greens covers. We will do the champ first and then the Cameron. It is almost a wrap. Rats.

Piles: You may have noticed a few small piles of dirt to the right of #6 champ tee. Every year, we generate debris consisting of sod, leaves, clipping, soil, and rock, and we re-use those materials on-site rather than hauling them to the landfill. We typically shape these materials into small mounds and seed them which we hope to complete before winter sets in.

Sod: We didn't get the sod laid on #7 or #9 bunker faces last week. We hope to get it done this week, but there is a lot going on as we put everything away for the winter, and the weather is not cooperating....to put it mildly!
