Wrap It Up: The finish line is rapidly approaching, but it is all up hill from here! The final fungicide application will go out today on the greens, and we have a few other loose ends to spray as well. After that, we will install the insulation sheets on about 100 sprinkler heads, the ones that almost always break in the winter, and then it's on to the tubes and covers. If you have any pull at all, please ask for the rain to stop while we install the covers. They are heavy enough without the extra weight of rainwater!

The Plan: So the plan is to install the greens covers with ventilation tubes underneath as was used last year. In addition, we will be placing multiple bait stations under each cover to try and decrease the mice damage. The sequence will be as follows: the Champ greens first going in reverse order, then the practice greens then onto the Cameron. Our goal is to get 9 covers installed each day beginning on Tuesday. If it rains, we may not be able to accomplish that goal. So you may get to play the entire Champ on Monday after we spray greens. Then on Tuesday, you can play the champ up to the point where are covering a green. On Wednesday, and if we are on schedule, you may be able to play some of the Champ front 9, but only until you reach us installing covers. The Cameron will certainly be playable on Monday through Wednesday and possibly on Thursday. By the end of the week, the only portion of the course that will be open will be the driving range, and I suspect that will close in 7 days.
