May 2017 - Greens Notice

Dear Members,

We intend to commence some treatments starting next Monday 22nd May for 2/3 days.

Over the last 4 – 5 weeks the dry conditions combined with severe cold winds have prevented our greens staff continuing with their program of work on the greens.

Warmer, damper conditions now allow that program to be resumed.

The work will consist of:

- 1. Solid tining of the new 9 holes (this has already been done on the “old” greens).**
- 2. Scarify all 18 greens with our own equipment.**
- 3. Top dress with sand and brush in.**
- 4. Spray all greens with the required chemicals**

This is essential work and needs to be done to reap the benefits in 2-3 weeks when the growth will start to appear.

There may be slight disruption if we have any home team matches next Tuesday / Wednesday.

We apologies for any inconvenience and seek your patience.

We remind all golfers that, in the interest of Health & Safety, green staff have priority on the course. Please give way to staff whilst working on the greens. Temporary greens maybe in play only as work is ongoing.

There has much hard work gone into getting the superb conditions that we now enjoy on the course. May we also take this opportunity to remind all members:

- Make a point of repairing pitch marks on the greens – even if they are not yours!**
- If you are in a bunker – make a thorough job of raking it after play.**
- Practicing on the course is NOT ALLOWED – a MAXIMUM of 2 balls may be played during “casual play”**
