The Southern New England Women's Golf Association (SNEWGA) board of directors has been working hard this winter scheduling the tournaments and many events and dates are already posted on the website, www.snewga.org. Additional details will unfold as we get closer to opening day.

With approximately 40 member golf courses, SNEWGA provides a great opportunity to play different courses and meet new friends. The membership fee remains at **\$15.00** per year and is due by **April 1, 2018** (after April 15 add an additional \$5.00).

Spring Meeting - Save the Date! The Opening Day Meeting & Golf Mixer will be on April 14 at Oronoque GC.

There are team events, individual events and partnership events. On the list of major tournaments below, an asterisk (*) denotes those that are individual formats you can sign up for on your own. The other tournaments must be coordinated through me, your SNEWGA representative.

Brief Description of Major Tournaments

Team Day: 4-member team competing for gross & net prizes. We can send as many teams as we can formulate, minimally two, a gross and net team.

Memorial: 4-member team competing for gross and net prizes. This team consists of an A, B C, & D player—again, we can enter numerous teams.

Pro Lady: 4-member team consisting of 3 women and 1 PGA professional.

***Individual Championship** - Open to all members, gross & net prizes.

***Senior Individual Championship** - Open to all members ages 50-62, gross & net prizes.

***Super Senior Individual Championship** -Open to all members ages 63-69, gross & net prizes.

***Legends Individual Championship** – open to all members age 70 and older, gross & net prizes.

***Member/Member:** 2-member teams compete against the field. This is not a club event, so you can play with **any** SNEWGA member from any club.

Spring Cup: This is a great event and opportunity to play at a variety of clubs. We can send as many 2 member teams as we want. You will play multiple rounds at various courses, competing against other clubs. **This is the first partner-event of the season, so start thinking about this and find a buddy!**

Presidents Cup: Another 2 member net event whereby each club participates in a stroke play tournament to determine the Regional Champion. The four Regional Champion teams then advance to compete for the Presidents Cup. We are promised a sunny tournament due to our suffering in last year deluge!
