RINGERS: This is your total score for 18 holes, using the best you have scored on each hole throughout the season. The lowest scores are rewarded prizes at the end of the season.

WEEKLY SWEEPS: These are weekly tournaments, called Sweeps. They can be played from Monday through Sunday. You make your own tee time, other than on Thursday mornings when we have set starting times in the morning, and can play with anyone you want as long as you are playing with, and your scorecard is attested by, a player who has a GHIN. Prize money awarded.

TOURNAMENTS: Major Tournaments are primarily 1-day or 2-day Club Tournaments held on Saturdays and/or Sundays. This year's Tournaments are as follows:

Opening Day – 4 player teams	April 21
PYOP Scramble – 2 player teams	May 5
Memorial – 4 player teams, minimum 1 guest per team	May 26
Spring Handicap – singles net stroke play	June 2-3
ABCD – “Moneyball” format with ABCD teams	June 16
President's Cup – singles net stroke play	June 30
Match Play vs. Hunter (at Timberlin)	July 14
Club Championship – singles gross stroke play	August 4-5
Hi-Lo 6-6-6 – 2 player teams	August 18
Match Play vs. Stanley (at Stanley)	September 1
Pro's Tournament – singles net stroke play	September 22
Member – Member - 2 player better ball	September 29
Closing Day – 4 player teams	October 13

The sign-up sheets for each sweep and/or tournament are posted in the Women's locker room. You can also sign up by emailing or calling the Tournament Chair, Sheila Allen, one week in advance [allensheilae@gmail.com or at 914-299-4382]. All tournament dates will also be listed in the club booklet. *NOTE: Tournament prizes will be awarded for 10 of the 13 Tournaments listed above. The exceptions are the Memorial and the two Match Play events (vs. Hunter & Stanley); these tournaments allow non-members to participate, so prize money for these events come from the separate entry fee. To participate in the Club Championship, you must have participate/played in at least 4 club events with at least one being a Major Tournament.*

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES: Social gatherings are scheduled for after the Opening and Closing Day Tournaments. These are held at the Club. Free lunch is included on both of these dates!

OPTIONAL HOLE-IN-ONE POOL – Additional \$10 fee (keeps you in the pool until someone scores a hole-in-one and wins the pool)!
