Membership comes with privileges and responsibilities. Tee times are blocked early on Saturday and Sunday so the members can have the early starts. But when we open up the golf course to our guests that have reserved tee times, they should be able to start at the time reserved. Members that want to play additional rounds need to check in the golf shop to determine the best place to start and the number of players that are going back out to play. Jumping in front of guests and other members with tee times is not being a responsible member.

**Note from the General Manager ~** Guest

Policy and Rider Fees are being misused by members and guests. The Guest Policy for the club is that an individual can only play as a guest two times per month. After that they will have to pay the applicable current greens fee. Non-members either pay the daily trail fee for their private cart or they pay the cart fee to rent a cart. The guest riding at no charge can only be used twice per month.
