Rules and Course Marking Committee ~

This committee held its initial meeting on June 19th with Rick Gregory, Carole Overton, Steve Jones, Jerrell Harris, and Brent Edmister in attendance, plus a visit by Ron Birdwell.

After a good discussion on several issues, the following changes are going to be implemented on the golf course prior to the Club Championship:

- The Lateral Hazard left of number 14 green has been removed. This area will be played as rough.
- The Lateral Hazard stakes on #17 will be moved to the tree line on the left side.
- The Water Hazard on #18 will be reinstated. This will give all players the additional option of taking a drop out of the hazard and hitting a third shot if they lose a ball in this area.

We also discussed the cart traffic on the golf course and where and when to drive in the fairway versus the rough, depending on the time of year. Look for more to come out on this soon.

They are responsible for maintaining an atmosphere that makes the pool accessible to all patrons. If one group's activity affects the enjoyment of other groups in the pool the activities will be suspended until allowed again by the guards.

Finally, with just about 6 weeks of the pool season left we are dropping the family pool anytime membership down to \$190 and the family weekday only membership down to \$150 for the rest of the summer. Come on out and enjoy the hottest days of the summer by the pool.

Private Golf Car Storage ~ We have finally issued our last private golf car storage location. Glow Ball Tournament ~ The first event will be held July 19th. This tournament is open to couples playing in a 4 person scramble format. Play for the first nine holes will begin at 5:30 on the back followed by dinner, then nine holes in the dark on the front. Cost is \$70/ couple. Cart and guest fees are extra. Sign up in the Golf Shop. *A second event is scheduled August 16th.*

Club Championship ~ The Oak Hills Club Championship is scheduled for the 26th and 27th of July and is open to all Oak Hills Members. The format is 36 holes of stroke play over two days. For Saturday's round, members can build their own groups within age divisions. Sunday's round pairings will be determined by round one scores with the leaders in each flight going off last. Saturday's rounds will start at 8 am with the younger divisions going off first and Sunday's round will start at 10:30 with the older divisions going off first and the Championship flight going off last.

Breakfast will be available Saturday morning at your own expense and dinner will be provided after Sunday's round as part of the entry fee. Entry Fee is \$30 per player. There are no prizes for this event - just bragging rights.
