Looking for 2016 Board Members ~ It is the time of year when we are looking to fill the spots on the board that will be open the end of this year. Service would start following the January Annual Members Meeting. If you are interested in serving your club or you have a nomination to suggest please contact Bob Walker or Rick Binkley.

Two Person Tournament ~ This event will be held on Saturday, September 19th with an 8:30am shotgun start. Format for play is a two person best ball over 27 holes. Teams will be flighted after 18 holes. Flights will be determined by the number of teams entered. Final nine will be played on front or back by flight. Members are encouraged to invite guests to join them. Cost is \$120 per team which covers entry fee, closest to the pin prizes, cart/trail fees and lunch after 18 holes. Entry deadline is close of business Sept 16th.

Two Couple Tournament ~ This event will be held on Saturday, October 10th with an 12:30am shotgun start. Format for play is a four-person scramble. Members are encouraged to invite guests to join them. Cost is \$140 per couple which covers entry fee, closest to the pin prizes and lunch after the round. Cart and trail fees are extra. Entry deadline is close of business October 7th.

New Saturday Handicap Game ~ Several Members are looking to start a new handicap game on Saturday mornings where the ball is played down and the rules of golf are encouraged so that score can be posted for handicaps. The group will play between 7:30 am and 8:00 am depending on the numbers. Payouts will be based on Net scores after handicaps are developed. **Please contact the golf shop to be added to this tee time.**

If you already have a handicap you are all set. If you have not started a handicap yet, get one set up in the golf shop for \$25 for the year.

Monthly/Annual Member Cart Fees ~ The board has approved establishing member monthly/annual cart fees. Currently they are

researching the cost of this offer. If you have any suggestions please contact a board member or the general manger. We want to start offering this option as soon as possible.

Checking in the Golf Shop ~ We request members check in the golf shop, during operational hours, to get added to the tee sheet so we can track rounds for the board of directors. There are players heading straight to the tee, without coming in the golf shop to go play golf. Additionally, if you are going back out for additional holes please inform the golf shop who and how many are going back out to play so they can be added to the tee sheet again. It is important for the business of the club to have a more accurate number of rounds that are played by members and our guest. A reminder that cart fees are for 9 or 18 holes, they are not for all day play. Please help keep the golf shop informed so that we are less appt to put someone out on the course in front of you if we know where you are playing.

Fall Aerification is Coming ~ Weather permitting fall aerification is scheduled for September 22nd and 23rd. Again we would appreciate volunteer help for clearing greens of plugs and getting them back ready to play as quickly as possible.

VETS Play Free ~ This coming Verterns day, *Wednesday, November 11th* we are inviting Veterans to play Oak Hills for free. Vets must have proof of service. Invite your friends and family that are or have served our great country to come play!

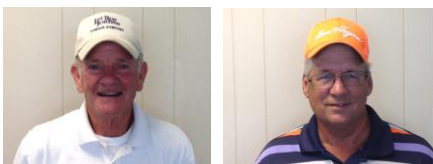

Note from the General Manager ~

Summer is now behind us and kids are back in school, but we are headed into the best part of the season for the golf course. September usually brings cooler weather and better growing conditions for our greens. To take advantage of these climate changes, we will start fall aerification in mid-September giving greens the best chance to heal from the stress of summer.

We are also set to begin the renovations on the golf course that the board has approved for this year. Josh Reasoner is the main contractor for the changes and he is scheduled to start the second week of September. Work will start with forming the new green near the gold tees on the second hole, reworking the blue / white tee to make it a larger teeing area. Once this area is ready to be sodded the bent grass will be pulled from #5 green and then #5 will be reworked to reduce the slope and then it will be sodded from #7 green.
