## When will the membership changes take effect?

The new membership changes will take effect on Oct. 1, 2017. Since membership dues are pre-paid, you will be billed for your new membership level on your Sept. 30, 2017 statement.

#### What happens to my membership if I am currently a Tennis member?

Unless instructed otherwise, your membership will convert to the "Athletic" membership effective 10/1/17. If you would like to convert to a different membership please send your request in writing to Cypress Lakes Country Club.

## What happens to my membership if I am currently a Social member?

Unless instructed otherwise, your membership will convert to the "Athletic" membership effective 10/1/17. If you would like to convert to a different membership please send your request in writing to Cypress Lakes Country Club.

## Do the new "Athletic" and "Community" memberships have a Food & Beverage minimum?

Yes, ALL membership levels have a \$35.00 Food & Beverage minimum per month.

## Can "Community" members use the pool amenity?

No, you must be an "Athletic" or "Golf" member to utilize the pool amenity.

#### Is there a Summer Only pool membership?

No.

#### When does the \$750.00 initiation fee go into effect?

Effective November 1, 2017, all new memberships and any membership level changes will be subject to approval by the Board of Directors and will be subject to the initiation fee. The Board of Directors of Cypress Lakes Country Club reserves the right to change or waive the initiation fee.

#### Can I place my account on "Hold" temporarily?

Membership holds are generally not allowed. Any exceptions must be approved by the President of Cypress Lakes Country.

## What if I am an annual Social member and pre-paid the \$55 per month rate for the pool for a year?

Your membership can be converted to either the "Community" or "Athletic" membership level. If you choose "Community", you will no longer be able to use the pool amenity. If you choose "Athletic", you would be required to pay the difference between "Social" and "Athletic" for the remainder of your annual membership or convert to the monthly payment option.

#### What if I would like to cancel my membership?

Please send your cancellation request in writing to Cypress Lakes Country Club. Reminder, all cancellations require 30 days written notice.

## What if I cancel and would like to rejoin again in the future?

First of all, we would love for you to remain a member and not cancel your membership, but if you do, then you would be required to pay the initiation fee when you rejoin in the future.

## Will the golf course become private?

No, as of now the golf course will not become private.

## Will the Restaurant and Bar become private?

Yes, effective 11/1/17, the restaurant and bar will be private. Members may bring guests, but guests must be accompanied by a member. Guest golfers may dine in the restaurant and bar with receipt from round of golf for that day.

## Are the Gourmet Dinner Club and Wine Tasting open to the public?

As of now, the Gourmet Dinner Club is for members only and members may bring guests to Wine Tastings for a higher price.
