- Tee Block changing duties
- Bunker maintenance
- Walk-behind cutting & Tri Plex cutting
- Weed-eating and flymo/pushmower work
- Operate within set safety guidelines
- Garbage collection
- Addition duties may be assigned as required

Qualifications:

- Able to demonstrate a growing knowledge of equipment operation as time progresses
- Self-motivated. Strong performer
- Able to positively interact with co-workers, and public
- An understanding of the game of golf is an asset
- Regularly required to stand, walk, bend, sit, and reach with hands
- Ability to lift/move objects up to 60lbs
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions
