Board News & Notes

April has arrived. I want to start by talking about our financial situation. April is the beginning of our financial year so it is appropriate to give a brief overview of performance this past year. We are expecting to be cash positive from operations, increase our capital fund and are retaining our hurricane/tornado insurance settlement monies in a separate account. What this means is that your board and staff have done an outstanding job of managing the club, working through hurricane remediation and focusing on the clubs future needs. All that being said. We are just slightly better than break even, paying our taxes on time and slowly improving our facilities. Our membership stands at 350 members with 10 on medical leave. The boards goal is to have membership at 375 by the end of this year. This growth will help accelerate our improvement plans and assist in stabilizing our financial security. **The club is in better shape, but not out of the woods.** Long term debt, major capital, improvements, membership stability are major hurdles to reaching our goal of being the best club in Eastern NC.

I will close with the following statement. I have been hearing whispers that the board is planning to substantially assess the membership this year to fund green replacement. As I said last month, the board has no plans for an assessment. We are in the planning and evaluation process only, with the goal of presenting a plan forward at the annual meeting in June. Well, Spring has just about sprung and we are excited that boating season is upon us. Therefore we wanted to remind everyone of a couple of things.

First of all, our fuel hours soon will be posted. They will be Wednesday and Thursdays 10:00 am-5:00 pm, Friday thru Sunday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and by appointment Mondays and Tuesdays. Be on the look out for when these hours will begin. Please let your non-club member boating friends know that gas/diesel is available for their boats too at the public pricing.

Secondly, if you are a member that comes to the club by your boat, but do not have a boat slip, please use the GUEST SLIPS on the NORTH SIDE of B DOCK as your docking station. These are the first four slips closest to the club house. Other slips are leased and should not be used, nor should you dock at the ends of any dock as these areas are for specific uses for transients, gas/diesel, or pump out purposes. Also, should you need temporary space for your boat you should arrange everything through EARNIE.

Third, our pump out station is for club members only, or transients previously cleared by Earnie. This is a service WYCC provides only for its members.

We have refurbished our WIFI after the hurricane damage, and everything should be working as it should. As a boat slip lessee, please see Earnie for the docks password if you do not already have one. **Water is available on all docks now that freezing temperatures have abated.**

- **MONTHLY BILLING CYCLE:** Members have the Calendar month (1st – 30th or 31st) in which to fulfill your Dining Minimum. Please remember not to wait until the end of the month to call for reservations. In some cases, we may be booked therefore; you would not meet your minimum for the month. **Remember:** Parties such as Birthdays, Book Clubs, Golf Dining, Super Clubs, Weddings, etc. **Do Not Count Towards Minimums.**

- **MEMBERSHIP DUES:** Any member whose dues are in arrears more than 30 Days will be notified that all privileges of membership are automatically suspended and shall not be reinstated **except upon payment of all delinquencies.** Suspension of any member more than one time during any 12 month period shall be cause for revocation of Club membership at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Any former member whose membership has been revoked under this section, shall, upon reapplication for membership, be required to pay all delinquencies plus the current initiation fee as prescribed by the Board of Directors.

- **MEMBERSHIP STATUS CHANGE:** Please remember to contact the office with any changes that may reflect your membership status. Example: Marriage, Divorce, Spouse's Death, Change of Address or have reached the age of 72 and been a continuous member for 10 years. We will be happy to assist you, so please call us if anything changes. **Remember: If you are over the age of 80 and have been a continuous member for 25 years, you are eligible for the Super Senior Membership.**

- **HAVEN'T RECEIVED YOUR STATEMENT?:** If it is past the 6th of the month and you have not received your statement, please give the office a call at 946-1514 extension 3 so that I can resend it to you.
