PRACTICE ROUNDS

One complimentary practice round per entrant is available after 12:00 PM on May 27 or anytime May 28 – May 31. Oregon City GC annual pass holders may use their practice round anytime on May 27. This is an 18-hole round and may not be broken up into two 9-hole rounds on separate days. No exceptions will be made - this is a practice round for the week of the tournament only. Please call in advance for tee times. **Play one ball only please.**

STARTING TIMES

Saturday starting times will be based on requested pairings (threesomes preferred but foursomes will be accommodated) or handicap. Sunday starting times will be based on Saturday's results.

TOURNAMENT CHAMPION

The competitor with the lowest 36-hole gross score, regardless of division, is considered the overall 2019 Oregon City Amateur champion. Each division and flight will have its own champion as well.

REDUCTION OF HANDICAP INDEX

The OGA Tournament Committee has instituted a policy by which they reserve the right to adjust the handicap index of any competitor in future competitions.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Contestants are expected to (1) know and play by the Rules of Golf, (2) conduct themselves at all times in a sportsmanlike manner, and (3) respect the golf course and the rights of other contestants. Those who exhibit unsportsmanlike conduct (cheat, damage the course, deface club property, use loud obscene language, throw clubs, etc.) are subject to immediate disqualification and possible suspension from future play.

DRESS CODE

Suitable attire must be worn at all times. Suitable attire does not include spandex, cut-offs, running shorts, running suits, or tank tops.

MOTORIZED CARTS

The use of motorized carts is permitted in tournament play. Contestants wishing to reserve a cart must do so with the Club. Cart reservations will be made on a first come, first serve basis. Cart fees must be paid by the contestant to the club at the time of rental. Carts are \$15 per rider.

CADDIES OR WALKERS

Caddies and spectators are welcome. Carts are \$15 per rider.

SPIKES

The use of metal spikes is prohibited.
